

ALYSSA AND JUSTIN HAUN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

INFORMATION FOR THE STUDENT APPLICANT

Standards of Selection:

1. College bound senior, pursuing a STEM course of study;
2. Cumulative Grade Point Average for seven (7) consecutive semesters of high school class work should place student in the top 20% of his/her class;
3. Have demonstrated high achievement in scholastic and extracurricular activities;
4. Have a record of performance in activities both in school and in the community;
5. Have a sound interest in positively impacting others;
6. Have completed and executed the Waiver set forth on Page 1 of the attached scholarship application;
7. Complete the attached Scholarship Application;
8. Have a principal, counselor, teacher or other extracurricular adult advisor complete a letter of recommendation for you for this scholarship;
9. Have a transcript of your high school grades attached to the scholarship application; and
10. **Submit this scholarship application, with all blanks appropriately completed, to the HHS Counseling Department by March 6.**

The Scholarship Selection Committee will rank applications based on overall academic achievement. Final selection will be based on the applicant's essay.

Scholarship Renewal:

Alyssa and Justin Haun Memorial Fund Scholarship Awards are eligible for renewal, for up to three years, provided the scholarship recipient remains in contact with The Highland Foundation for Educational Excellence. Renewal eligibility is determined by a Scholarship Selection Committee review process that occurs at the end of the spring term for those students who:

1. Received Alyssa and Justin Haun Memorial Scholarship funding during the previous year;
2. Maintain a 3.0 or higher GPA, achieve sufficient academic credits to advance to the next class year (i.e. second year students must be considered sophomores or higher) and remain within a STEM degree program;
3. Submit a letter to The Highland Foundation for Educational Excellence (3880 Ridge Rd., Medina, OH 44256) describing progress toward his/her goal- consider sharing an opportunity seized that has taken you closer to your goal by January 1; and
4. Include a transcript or report of their hours completed for the year and overall cumulative GPA at the institution where the student received funding with the letter.
